How many baking pans in all? = 15 (R) · There were 34 baking pans. 2 were used up. How many baking pans are left? = 32 (A) · Baker Ben found 16 sprinkles yesterday and 13 more today. How many sprinkles in all? = 29 (O) · Baker Ben lined up 3 rows of 10 baking pans. How many baking pans in all? = 30 (N) · There were 28 sprinkles. 5 were used up. How many sprinkles are left? = 23 (U) · Baker Ben found 7 baking pans yesterday and 10 more today. How many baking pans in all? = 17 (C)
