3. Use each clue to cross suspects off the list. The one suspect left at the end is the culprit!

How many brass gears in all? = 106 (E) · Captain Copter found 35 brass gears yesterday and 6 more today. How many brass gears in all? = 41 (I) · Captain Copter lined up 9 rows of 5 spyglass lenses.
