How many cyber-football did each get? = 26 (R) · Coach Barnaby earned 2 glow-in-the-dark sneakers in each of 2 rounds, plus 24 bonus glow-in-the-dark sneakers. Then 11 glow-in-the-dark sneakers were lost. How many glow-in-the-dark sneakers are left? = 17 (L) · Coach Barnaby collected 33 robo-whistles in the morning and 51 robo-whistles in the afternoon, then split them equally among 6 The Comet Climbers.
