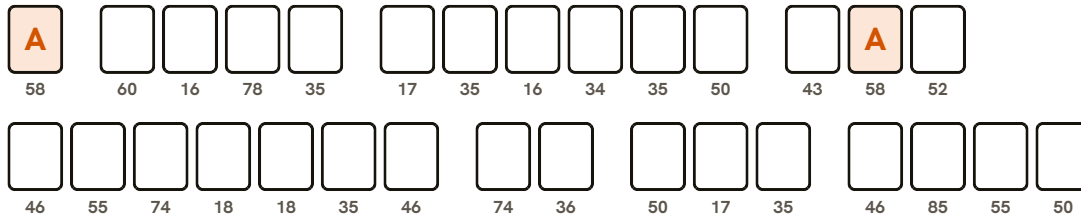

10. The villain breaks the chest with an iron sword, then sets off a loud tnt block.
11. The villain chops down the door with a netherite axe, then sets off a loud tnt block.
12. The villain digs up the floor with a diamond pickaxe, then lights up the room with a glowstone block.
