Baker Betty found 4 candles yesterday and 10 more today. How many candles in all?

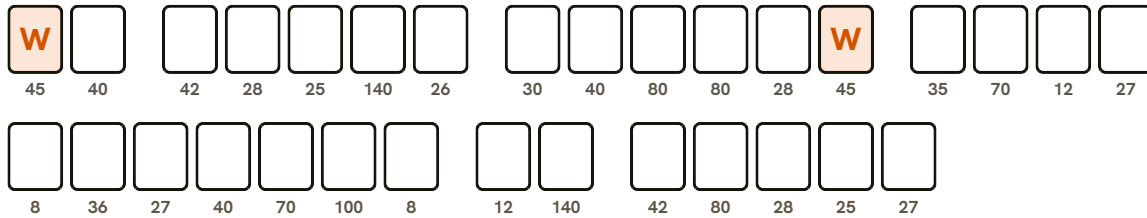
